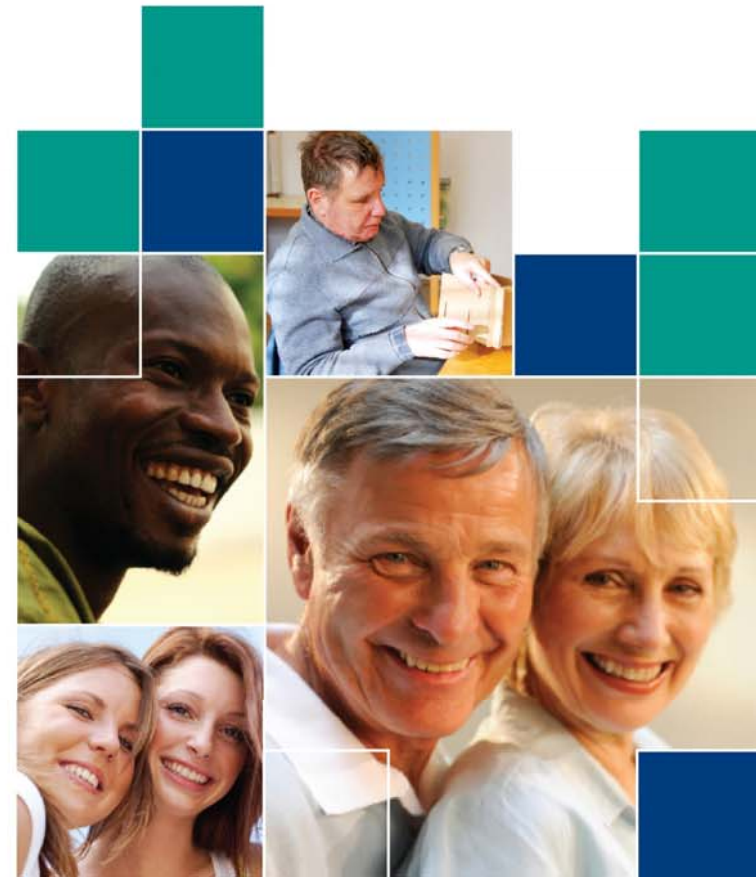

## Who is MINOSA House For?

MINOSA House is a supported accommodation program for single men aged over 18 years, not accompanied by children, who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

MINOSA House is funded by the ACT Department of Disability, Housing and Community Services and is delivered by CatholicCare.

## MINOSA House Facilities?

MINOSA House can accommodate 7 residents in individual rooms. Residents have access to a communal lounge, kitchen, bathrooms and laundry facilities.

## MINOSA House can provide you with

- A supported accommodation bed for up to 3 months, including breakfast and dinner
- Case management, including planning goals, providing you with support, information and advocacy in assisting you to achieve your goals
- Support to gain and transition into and/or sustain tenancies in public, community or private accommodation. Including filling in forms, gathering documentation, providing practical and material assistance
- Help with living skills including budgeting, health, nutrition and personal care
- Assistance in the development of social networks and giving you information about community events.

## Referrals

MINOSA House staff can offer referral to other support services including Mental Health, Alcohol and/or other drug related services, Doctors, Dentists, Counselling services, Employment and/ or training agencies.
