Youth Connections Team Leader Central – Full Time

CatholicCare Canberra and Goulburn Archdiocese will be managing the new Youth Connections Program which supports young people aged between 11 and 19 years of age to attain their Year 12 or equivalent and to help them make a successful transition through education and onto further education, training or work.

- The Program will offer a range of flexible and individualized services to young people who are most at risk of disengaging from school through to those who are severely disengaged from education, family and community.
- As team leader, you would be responsible for providing assistance to, and engaging young people who are at risk of, or are disengaged from education within a flexible and tailored case management framework and through innovative youth focused activities.
- The Team Leader Central position will be based at our Queanbeyan Office and will initially be for a 9 month period, with the possibility of a further 12 months.
- The successful applicant will possess qualifications and/or experience in a relevant discipline and will ideally have experience working with young people.
